St Cosme Cote du Rhone Blanc 2018, \$21

2018 was balanced and fresh. The terroir has been properly conveyed and basically, this is a great classic white Le Poste. Flint, fennel, grapefruit. Scents of honey accent notes of white peach and lime on the nose of the 100% Clairette 2018 Cotes du Rhone Le Poste. It's barrel fermented and aged, but in older wood, leaving the fruit and the terroir to speak largely on their own. It's medium-bodied, with ample concentration, a silky-textured plumpness on the mid-palate and a long, lime- and grapefruit-laced finish.

Delas - Côte du Ventoux 2018, \$15

Its color is a deep ruby red, showing garnet reflections while young. With its predominately berry-fruit bouquet, this wine shows the full aromatic power of these two noble grape varieties whilst retaining the freshness imparted by well-controlled wine making.

Roger Sabon Cote du Rhone 2019, \$19

Famille Sabon farms 6 hectares of vines in Côtes-du-Rhône on the western bank of the Rhône river near Lirac. These are all clay and limestone terroirs planted primarily with Grenache with about 10% each Syrah & Cinsault. Each vintage this wine stands out as one of our best CDR values and in 2019 this is doubly so. With a floral expression that we've long associated with vines situated in this southwestern part of the Rhône Valley, the Rhône by Roger Sabon features delicate and racy red and black cherry flavors with just a hint of licorice and pepper all in an easy drinking style.
